

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS / PRECAUTIONS

The manufacturer cannot be held responsible for damage which is caused by not using the RF Modulator in compliance with the safety instructions or precautions.

- Do not open casing of the RF Modulator at any time, **NO** user serviceable parts can be found inside.
- Ensure mains power is disconnected **BEFORE** any connections are made to the Video Reader and RF Modulator. To switch off the Video Reader completely, you must disconnect it from the mains, the captions on/off button does **NOT** switch the mains power off.
- Do not expose the RF Modulator to rain or any other source of moisture.
- Do not place the RF Modulator close to sources of heat, such as radiators.

SECTION 'A' - Installation/Connections

- Refer to your *Video Reader*TM Owners Manual for initial installation / connection details.
- Place the *RF Modulator* in a convenient position behind your *Video Reader*TM.
- Your *RF Modulator* is supplied ready for use and comes complete with the connecting lead for connection to your *Video Reader*TM and an Aerial/RF coaxial lead for connection to your TV.

For ALL installations :

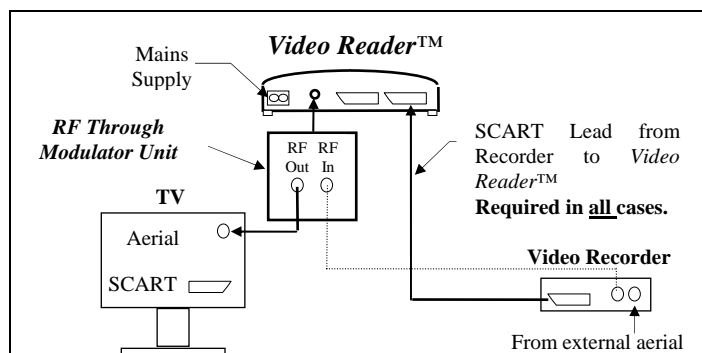
- Refer to your *Video Reader*TM Owners Manual.

As you do not have a SCART(AV) socket on your TV:

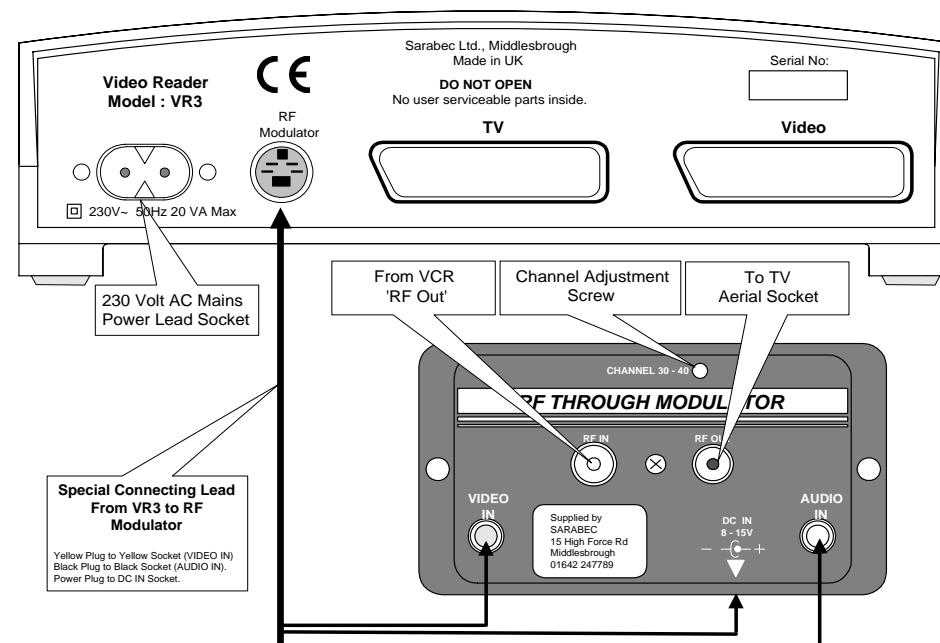
- Connect the RF Modulator connecting lead to the RF Modulator socket on the rear of your *Video Reader*TM
- Connect the RF/Aerial lead (supplied), pin end, into the Aerial socket of the TV.
- Connect the other end, socket end, of this lead into the 'RF out' socket on the *RF Modulator*.
- Connect your existing RF/Aerial lead, pin end, to the 'RF in' socket on the *RF Modulator*.
- Connect the other end, socket end, of this lead into the 'RF out' socket of the video recorder.

- **DOUBLE CHECK ALL CONNECTIONS.**

- Switch on the mains supply to the *Video Reader*TM, TV and video recorder.

SECTION 'B' - Tuning In Television

As you are using the RF Modulator option:

- You will need to tune your TV in the same way as you did when tuning in for standard TV channels and your video recorder.
- The RF Modulator output is pre-set for channel 38, *please ensure that this channel is different to the channel of your video recorder.*
- Select a spare channel on the TV (**NOT** your normal Video channel), e.g. 6 or 7.
- Play a pre recorded **Closed Captioned Tape** and Tune the TV until you see a captioned picture on the screen. (on some TVs you may need to store the selected channel after tuning, refer to your TV manual).

SECTION 'C' - Playing a Closed Captioned Video

You are now ready to watch a closed captioned video.

- Please refer to your *Video Reader*TM Owners Manual for instructions on playing closed captioned video's.

SECTION 'D' - Problems and Cures

Problem	Cure
Captions not visible	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Re-check all connections.• When using RF Modulator & Aerial lead to TV, check tuning.• Use a compatible "□" video cassette.• Try another compatible "□" video cassette.

If in doubt please contact your dealer for assistance.

SECTION 'E' - Specification

Input connections	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Via special AV / power lead with 4 pin DIN plug (Supplied) for direct connection to <i>Video Reader</i>TM RF Modulator socket.• RF / Coaxial socket (Labelled: RF In) for connection to a VCR RF Out socket via coaxial lead.
Output connections	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• RF / Coaxial socket (Labelled: RF Out) for connection to a TV RF (aerial) socket via coaxial lead.
Controls	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• RF Modulator Channel 30-40 adjustment screw.
