

Website: Acceptable Use Policy

Our Website Acceptable Use Policy sets out the terms on which visitors are permitted to use the features of our websites www.sarabec.com and www.sarabec.com This policy applies to all users of, and visitors to, our sites.

This Policy is to be read in conjunction with the following:

- <u>Cookie Policy</u>. Provides the necessary information about our website's use of cookies.
- <u>Privacy Policy</u>. Sets out our policy in relation to the collection, storage and use of personal data.
- Website Terms of Use. Sets out the terms of access and use of our websites.

Your use of our site means that you accept, and agree to abide by, all the policies in this acceptable use policy, which supplement our Website Terms of Use.

Prohibited uses

You may use our site only for lawful purposes. You may not use our site:

Content standards
